UPDATE ON 2nd CYCLE 2021 FOREIGN PHARMACY GRADUATE ORIENTATION PROGRAMME (FPGOP)

The second cycle of 2021 FPGOP is scheduled to hold from August 15 to September 24, 2021 at two (2) PCN designated Centres namely: Faculty of Pharmacy, University of Ilorin, Ilorin, Kwara State (North) and Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, University of Port-Harcourt, Port-Harcourt, Rivers State (South).

There are **Regular (6weeks)** and **Online (3weeks)** programmes. The Regular programme is for Pharmacy Graduates with less than five (5) years post qualification experience while the Online programme is for candidates with more than five (5) years post qualification practice experience with current Annual license in their country of training or residence.

Registration has commenced and interested participants are requested to apply attaching relevant documents namely:

- i) A duly completed Application Form;
- ii) O'level result (with five (5) credits passes in English Language, Mathematics, Physics, Biology and Chemistry);
- iii) Two (2) passport-size photograph;
- iv) Degree Certificate,
- v) Birth Certificate/Age Declaration;
- vi) Original copy of Academic Transcript;
- vii) Certificate of Registration or Annual license to practice (where applicable);
- viii) Evidence of payment)

Applicants without the relevant documents as listed above **NEED** not apply for this programme. Only **Original Transcripts** and **notarized photocopies** of other documents shall be accepted. .

The Registration fee is \$900 for the regular and \$1500 for online participants. (The exchange rate is N410 per Dollar).

Participants are to **CLEARLY** indicate on their Application Form their Centre of Choice for the Orientation Programme.

Online participants are expected to join the regular participants at their respective Centres of choice on **Monday, September 06, 2021**.

Deadline for submission/uploading of all Application Forms and relevant documents is **Monday**, **August 09**, **2021**. Late applications shall not be accepted.

Applicants with incomplete documents shall not be shortlisted for the programme.

PLEASE NOTE that graduates from International University, Bamenda, Cameroun and Institut Bilingual University, Togo are expected to attach in addition to other relevant documents:

- i) Duplicate Photo page of International Passport;
- ii) Immigration stamped passport pages of entry and exit from respective countries of training throughout the duration of the Pharmacy training programme.
